## October brings GFA winner Dimitri Illarionov to OCGC



Now that the summer is over, we are ready to start the 2003-'04 season of guitar concerts! The OCGC is proud to present the 2002 GFA winner, Dimitri Illarionov.

Dimitri was born in the former Soviet Union in 1979 and began playing guitar at the age of seven. At this young age, he knew he would one day be a professional musician and performer. He was soon studying privately. In 1993, he entered the Moscow State Conservatory to begin formal training at the age of 13. He continued his education at Russia's Gnesin Academy of Music where he graduated with honors.

He has entered and won prizes at several international guitar competitions in Russia, Belgium, Poland and the Czech Republic. In October, 2002 he won first prize at the twentieth International Guitar Foundation of America guitar competition in Miami, Florida.

Every year, the GFA holds the International Guitar Competition at its annual convention. As part of the prize package, Dimitri will be awarded a 50 city concert tour throughout the

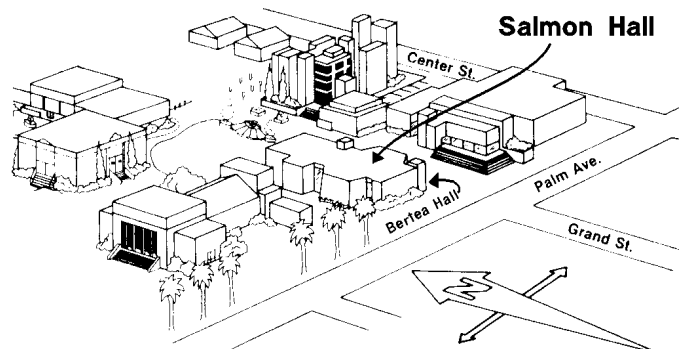
United States, Canada, Mexico, Russia and Germany in addition to a CD recording and a video on the Mel Bay guitar series label.

Dimitri will be performing works by Bach, Giuliani, Tansman, Barrios, Tedesco, Koshkin and Sergio Assad, among other works.

The concert will begin at **8 p.m.** at Chapman University's Salmon Hall on **Saturday, October 18**. OCGC members are admitted free of charge. Guests and other non-members are asked to pay \$7 at the door.
