	<p>September 21 <i>Colin Davin</i> Colin Davin is quickly emerging as one of today's most dynamic young artists, lauded as possessing "a virtuoso's technique, a deeply expressive musicianship, and a probing imagination". Having studied with Bill Kanengeiser, Sharon Isbin and Jason Vieaux, Davin has performed to rave reviews across the US as both a soloist and ensemble player.</p>
	<p>November 16 <i>The Commonwealth Guitar Trio</i> This Southern California group is made up of the preeminent USC-trained musicians Kevin Ayers, Daniel de Arakal and Jon Minei. They are rapidly building their reputation as Orange County's premier guitar trio.</p>
	<p>February 15 <i>Rovshan Mamedkuliev</i> Azerbaijani-born Rovshan Mamedkuliev was the first prize-winner at the prestigious Guitar Foundation of America Competition in 2012, and now stands as one of the world's most exciting young instrumentalists. His appearance for the OC Guitar Circle is one stop on the national concert and master class tour which he won as part of the GFA prize.</p>
	<p>May 17 <i>Scott Tennant</i> Scott Tennant has long been recognized as one of the world's premier guitar virtuosos. A founding member of the Grammy-winning Los Angeles Guitar Quartet and author of the best-selling techniques handbook "Pumping Nylon", he's also trained some of the finest classical guitarists of the present generation.</p>
